While at CIA, Ms. Marriott served as a subject matter expert on Russian leadership, political decision-making, and small-group dynamics. providing written analysis and in-person briefings for the White House, National Security Council (NSC), Congress, and other US and foreign policymakers. n 2014, she was appointed by CIA as the daily intelligence briefer for the President's Special Assistant and NSC Senior Director for Russia, the Vice President's Special Advisor for Europe and Eurasia, and the NSC Senior Director for Global Economics and Finance, a role in which she served as a primary liaison between the intelligence and policy communities.

Ms. Marriott has been recognized with the National Meritorious Unit Citation, the Director of National Intelligence's Presidential Daily Briefing Award, the Career Analyst Program's Outstanding Writing Award, and more than a dozen Exceptional Performance Awards.

Ms. Marriott then worked as an embedded counterintelligence analyst at FBI Seattle before transitioning to a strategic role focused on emerging threats and regional trends. She served as the principal intelligence analyst and program coordinator for the Domestic Director of National Intelligence Representative Program in Washington, Oregon, and Alaska, as well as FBI Seattle's counterintelligence liaison with local law enforcement, US Government agencies, and private sector partners. Ms. Marriott was also a recipient of the FBI Director's Leadership Award in 2018.

Since leaving public service, Ms. Marriott has worked both as a security and management consultant and as the General Manager of an international mountaineering guide service operating in more than 25 locations across all seven continents.
